- The School Must Have Been Negligent: Despite Oklahoma parents can sue schools for injuries, but only if negligence can be proven.
- You Must Prove Negligence: Success in these claims often hinges on demonstrating that the injury was foreseeable and preventable, such as from inadequate supervision or faulty equipment.
- The Injury Must Have Occurred During School Hours: For a negligence claim against the school to stick, the injury must have happened while the child had permission to be on the playground and was under supervision.
